COVID-19 Update - Glenfield Intermediate

We continue to follow the advice of the Ministries of Health and Education regarding the Covid-19 virus. Currently it is business as usual particularly around our core teaching and learning programmes. However, we are very aware of the containment guidelines announced by our Prime Minister, and ensuring we keep within the guidelines from the Secretary of Education.

We ask that health procedures be maintained, namely:

- Cough or sneeze into your elbow or by covering your mouth and nose with tissues
- Put used tissues in the bin or a bag immediately
- Wash your hands with soap and water often (for at least 20 seconds)
- Try to avoid close contact with people who are unwell
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose or mouth if your hands are not clean
- Avoid personal contact, such as kissing, sharing cups or food with sick people
- Avoid handshakes, hongi, hugging, and other physical contact
- Clean and disinfect frequently touched surfaces and objects, such as doorknobs
- Stay home if you are unwell and seek medical advice

I have met with the school cleaning company to ensure they are meeting our needs and expectations at this time.
